Senator Deb Fischer (R-Neb) is looking for Nebraska students to serve as interns for the spring semester. Paid internships will be given in the Washington D.C. office, along with the Nebraska offices in Lincoln, Omaha and Kearney. Internship applications are due November 15th.

Internships with Senator Fischer will provide a unique first-hand experience of Senate operations and the legislative process. **All Nebraska college students are encouraged to apply.**

Depending on your assigned location in the office, your responsibilities may include:

- Leading U.S. Capitol tours
- Processing constituent correspondence
- Attending briefings and committee hearings
- Compiling press clips
- Tracking legislation
- Monitoring Senate floor proceedings
- Drafting correspondence
- Assisting constituents with federal casework
- Conducting legislative research
