



JOB TITLE: Organizer-in-Training (Non-Paid Internship)

REPORTS TO: Field Director of Mayor Beutler's Re-Election Campaign

FUNCTION: Train to be a grassroots organizer. Provide support for and be a part of the field team for a mayoral campaign. Engage in direct voter contact to increase turnout.

ESSENTIAL DUTIES:

Participate in training and skill building exercises on the theory, practice, and ideology that Democratic campaigns employ in their grassroots organizing programs.

- 1) Cross train and shadow in other areas of the campaign to develop strong organizational knowledge.
- 2) Provide support to the campaign's field team and other staff. These duties may include, but are not limited to:
 - a. Recruit and train volunteers
 - b. Assist with phone and canvassing programs
 - c. Staff activist recruitment and outreach events
 - d. Input and track departmental data
 - e. Participate in departmental meetings as requested
 - f. Assist in the development and implementation of strategies to recruit, educate, and mobilize the activists in the community
 - g. Assist with electoral work
- 3) Other duties as assigned.

MINIMUM EDUCATION AND EXPERIENCE:

A commitment to progressive politics is required. Must demonstrate a strong desire to through local advocacy, activism, and organizing. Experience in direct sales/marketing, political campaigns, or social justice volunteer work is preferred, but not required.

REQUIRED:

Ability to maintain confidentiality of all campaign business and activities on and off the job. 15 hours per week expected time commitment.
